Attached is the Illinois / Missouri Area Championship Meet Packet. Please note the following pertinent information regarding team entries and parking

Information regarding parking:

The Kishwaukee YMCA lost some parking due to the demolition of the old hospital building which was adjacent to the YMCA. Therefore, additional parking will be made available this year at NIU's Speech-Lang-Hearing Clinic at 3100 Sycamore Road. There will be a shuttle to and from this lot during the meet. Families, with two or more adults, are encouraged to unload everyone, but the driver, at the YMCA. The driver then may proceed to park at the NIU lot, and return to the YMCA via the shuttle. More information regarding parking will be made available on our website at a later date.

Information regarding team entries:

- 1) We will be hosting a National Qualifying Meet on Friday night, prior to the Area meet on Saturday and Sunday. There are two event and fee summary sheets in this packet. One is for the National Qualifying Meet on Friday night, and one is for the Boys and Girls Championships on Saturday and Sunday. **Note – The Friday Night Meet is not a YMCA Sanctioned Meet.** It is an ISI sanctioned meet.
- 2) Entry Deadlines:
Boys and Girls Area Championships – Wednesday, March 9
Friday's National Qualifying Meet – Wednesday, March 16
- 3) **All teams who host a district meet are required to email a Meet Manager backup and a hard copy of the results of their meet to the Meet Entry Chairperson, Brian Bickner at dcst@kishymca.org at the conclusion of the meet, but no later than 9:00 AM on the day after their meet.**
- 4) Teams will be assessed a \$50 penalty if their entries are received after the deadline. If a team has unpaid fees or an unpaid penalty as of 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, March 19, 2011, all of that team's swimmers will be permanently scratched from both days of the Area Meet, and will not be deemed to have participated in the Area Meet.
- 5) Provide accurate, legible contact information with your entries for the Area Meet. We may need to contact you with questions regarding entries.
- 6) Teams are encouraged to send their entries via email.
- 7) For teams not sending their entries via email, Delivery by US Mail by a specific date is not guaranteed. Entries received by US Mail after the entry deadline will be assessed the \$50 penalty. Entries are required to be sent via FedEx or another private mailing service that guarantees delivery by a certain date.
- 7) Entries via fax will not be accepted.

- 8) Ensure that Club codes are the same as those listed in the “*Rules Governing Illinois / Missouri Area YMCA Swimming Competition*” document and are consistent between the District meets and the Area meet.
- 9) Scratches – Qualified swimmers that will not be swimming at the Area Championships must have their name highlighted on the hard copy of the entry form and initialed by the head coach.
- 10) Timers –All teams with eight or more swimmers on a given day will be required to supply timers. **Team timing assignments will be available at www.dcst.org on Wednesday, March 16.**
- 11) There will be a mandatory coaches’ informational and scratch meeting in room 4 at the Kishwaukee YMCA at 8:00 PM on Friday night. Team packets and coaches’ credential cards will be available at this time. **There will be no other coaches’ meetings.**
- 12) For teams and / or swimmers wanting times from the Area Meet entered into the USA Swimming’s SWIMS Database, you must fill out and return the form on page 13 of this packet with your entries. Teams not returning this form will not have swimmers entered into the SWIMS Database.

Facility The Kishwaukee YMCA has an 8-lane 25-yard competition pool with starting blocks in 7 feet of water at both ends. There is an additional 6 lane, 25-yard pool available for warm-up and warm-down during the meet. The facility uses non-turbulent lane lines with a fully automatic Colorado timing system. The meet will be run using Hy-Tek's Meet Manager 3.0. The seating capacity is for 700 spectators. A map is attached.

Swim-offs Any necessary swim-offs will be held no later than after the completion of the preliminary session and in any case after all swimmers affected have had at least 30 minutes to rest.

Time Trials "Open" time trials will be held both Saturday and Sunday following each day's final session. Both sexes will be swum on both days. All events offered at the Area and National championship Meets will be offered both days with the exception of the 1000 and 1650-yard Freestyle events. These two events will only be offered Saturday night and at the National Qualifying Meet on Friday night. The cost will be \$10.00 per individual event and \$40.00 per relay event. Only one try per event per day is allowed. Swimmers must provide timers and counters, if needed. Girls and boys heats may be combined.

Entries All swimmers qualifying for the 2011 Area Championships will automatically be entered from the disks that have been submitted by the hosts of the District Championships. Individual teams are also required to submit a hard copy of their entries. A Team Manager meet entry printout sorted by athlete is acceptable and preferred. **Do not submit this report on disk, a printed hard copy of a Team Manager report only. This report may be sent via email.** Teams are required to pay for all swimmers qualifying for the Area Championships unless a swimmer/entry is deleted in writing prior to the deadline set for the individual districts.

Qualified swimmers that will not be swimming at the Area Championships must have their name highlighted on the hard copy of the entry form and initialed by the head coach.

Teams will be assessed a \$50 penalty if their entry information is received after the deadline set by the host team. If any entry fees and/or penalty due from a team are not paid to the host at or before 8:00 AM on the first day of the Area Championships, then all swimmers from such team shall be automatically scratched from the Area Meet. A copy of the meet entries will be made available on the web at www.dcst.org by Wednesday, March 16. It is each team's responsibility to check the accuracy of its entries as posted. A signed Summary Fee/Release Form provided in this packet must accompany all entries. Entry fees should be paid by the conclusion of the coaches' meeting on Friday. Checks are to be made payable to "**Kishwaukee YMCA**". Please note there are separate forms for the Friday National Qualifying Meet and the Saturday/Sunday Area Meet.

Delivery by US Mail by a specific date is not guaranteed. Entries received after the entry deadline, will be assessed a \$50 penalty. FedEx or other private mailing service is required.

Bullpen

Prelims - There will be a bullpen for **all age groups** during the preliminary sessions. Swimmers must report to the bullpen, which will be located in the team area.

Finals - A bullpen will be provided for only the 8 and under swimmers during finals.

First Aid Emergency medical personnel will be available on deck during the meet. The Kishwaukee Hospital (815 - 756 - 1521) is located just around the corner from the YMCA on Route 23, and the Hospital offers emergency care. Kishwaukee Hospital's address is One Kish Hospital Drive, DeKalb, IL 60115.

Coaches (with proper identification) and non-swimming children under 12 will be admitted free.

Heat Sheets \$6.00 daily for preliminary and final sessions
\$2.00 daily for final sessions only

Concessions A concession area will be available throughout the meet.

Souvenirs A commemorative meet T-shirt will be on sale. Action Accents will also be available Saturday and Sunday to sell swimmers' supplies, swimwear, and other novelty or souvenir items.

Photos A podium will be positioned outside the pool area for families to take pictures of their swimmers after they receive their awards.

Rules This meet will be conducted according to the National YMCA "*Rules that Govern YMCA Competitive Sports*," the USA Swimming Technical Rules (blue pages) and the "*Rules Governing Illinois / Missouri Area YMCA Swimming Competition*" which can be found on the area website at www.ilmoymcaswimming.org. This meet will also be an Illinois Swimming Inc. approved meet.

Rules of Conduct Parental supervision of the swimmers in the locker rooms, the staging area, and the concessions area is a requirement for participation in the Area Championships. Lack of such supervision may result in disqualification of the team involved.

For the safety and enjoyment of swimmers and spectators, the following rules must be observed. Marshals will be clearly designated to assure that safety is maintained.

1. There will be no food, beverages, swim bags, coolers, blankets, or sleeping bags allowed in the pool area.
2. Flash photography will not be allowed in the pool area. Persons taking flash pictures will be warned only once. Subsequent violations will result in expulsion from the meet.
3. Use of tobacco products is not allowed in the YMCA. Outside of the YMCA, tobacco users are asked to use the designated smoking areas only.
4. No shaving will be allowed at the YMCA. Shaving by swimmers on the premises will result in automatic disqualification from the entire meet.
5. Following completion of the morning warm-ups, the non-competition pool can be used for warm-up and cool-down only.
6. The following items are prohibited from being set up in the team areas due to limited space: mattress, air beds, tables and hammocks.

Parking Parking is available in the YMCA parking lot, along one side of Health Services Drive and in adjacent business parking lots. Please pay special attention to which parking lots are available for parking and which are not. Parking in areas not designated as swim meet parking could result in towing fees. The Kishwaukee YMCA and the Kishwaukee YMCA Swim Team are not responsible for towing fees incurred while parked in non-designated swim meet parking.

Coaches' Certifications/Credential Card Only coaches whose names and certifications were forwarded to Dave Hedden (Joliet YMCA) from each District's Staff Designate, and who have received an Area Credential card from Dave Hedden will be allowed on deck. **NO credential cards will be issued at the meet.** Each coach with a current Area Credential card will be issued a wristband at the mandatory coaches meeting on Friday evening. Each team will be given 1 - 4 deck passes based on the number of swimmers each team has entered in the meet. Coaches must have both the deck pass and wristband to be allowed on deck. All coaches should have their current credential card on hand during the meet.

Coach's certification requirements are as follows:

- 1) Current certification in Red Cross CPR Professional Rescuer
- 2) Current certification in Red Cross First Aid
- 3) American Red Cross Coaches Safety Training and/or American Red Cross or YMCA Life guarding Certification
- 4) YMCA Principles of Competitive Swimming & Diving

Teams will be limited to the following number of coach deck passes according to the number of swimmers they have in attendance for the entire meet.

- 1 - 5 swimmers 1 coach deck pass
- 6 - 10 swimmers 2 coach deck passes
- 11 - 20 swimmers 3 coach deck passes
- 21 or more swimmers 4 coach deck passes

Officials The Officials Coordinators are Tom Alef (Northwest District) and Ron Marion (St. Louis District). Only those YMCA officials invited by the YMCA Area Committee will be allowed on deck. The official's uniform in the IL/MO YMCA Competitive swimming may be navy or white bottoms and white tops with white shoes and white socks. For Area Championship finals optional attire will be white pants with navy jacket.

Timers Teams with 8 or more swimmers participating on a given day will be required to supply timers. **Teams should check www.dcst.org on Wednesday, March 16th for specific assignments.**

Awards Championship medals will be awarded for first through eighth place following each event during finals. Awards for the 500-yard Freestyle will be given at the beginning of finals. Consolation awards for ninth through sixteenth places will be

available to team coaches, or their designated representatives, after completion of the meet. All awards must be picked up at the end of the meet. The host team will not be mailing any awards.

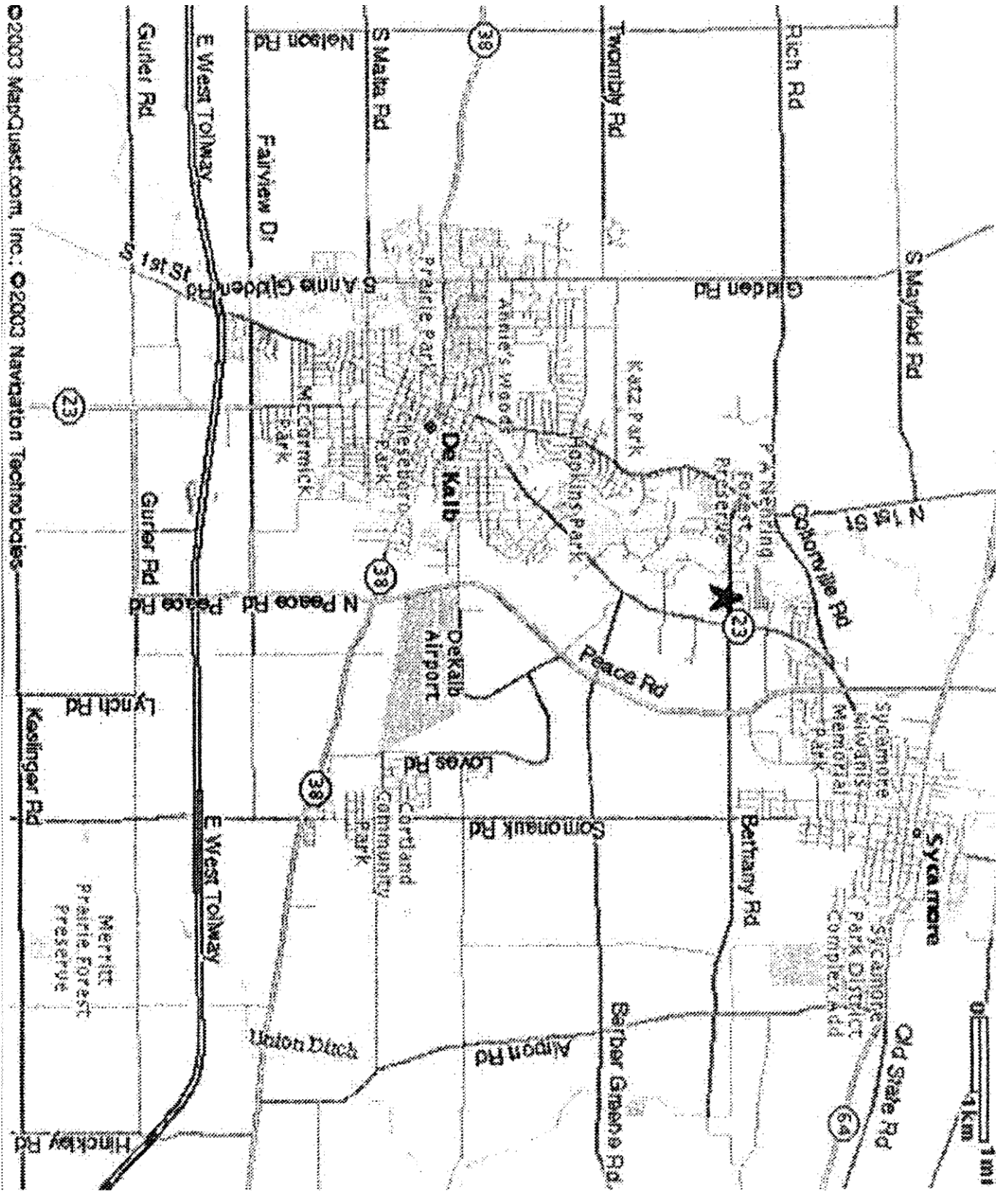
